



City of Oak Ridge North Pool Group Policy

For groups of 15 people or more, the City of Oak Ridge North requires prior notice. If groups do not give prior notice, admittance into the pool is not guaranteed. Cost is \$4 per person.

The following rules and regulations shall apply to all user groups, including but not limited to Day Care Centers and Camp Groups:

- One Group Supervisor shall be designated by the group and act as the liaison to the Oak Ridge North Pool Manager. The Group Supervisor must be at least 18 years old.
- Additional Supervisors must be of at least 16 years of age.
- Direct Supervision of the group members must be maintained at all times while the group is inside the gated pool area. This means that a staff person shall be physically present with the group and in a position where the Supervisors can see, hear, direct, and assess the activities of the group.

SAFETY IS OUR TOP PRIORITY!

- Lifeguards enforce facility rules and respond in emergencies.
- Group Supervisors are primarily responsible for maintaining the group, insuring that the group members are behaving accordingly, and following the City of Oak Ridge North's Pool Policies.
- Group Supervisors of day care groups and camp groups must be in bathing suit attire and must be either in the water with the children or at the edge of the pool where children are playing.
- Group Supervisors must ACTIVELY SUPERVISE and keep NON-SWIMMERS within arm's reach of an adult.
- Lifeguards and Aquatics Staff remain in charge at all times. Group supervisors are expected to support the aquatic staff in enforcement of all pool rules and regulations.
- User groups whose members or supervisors fail to follow facility rules and regulations may be asked to leave the pool.
