Please notify our office of any additional debris that you know of in your pct./city/jurisdiction that has not yet been collected.

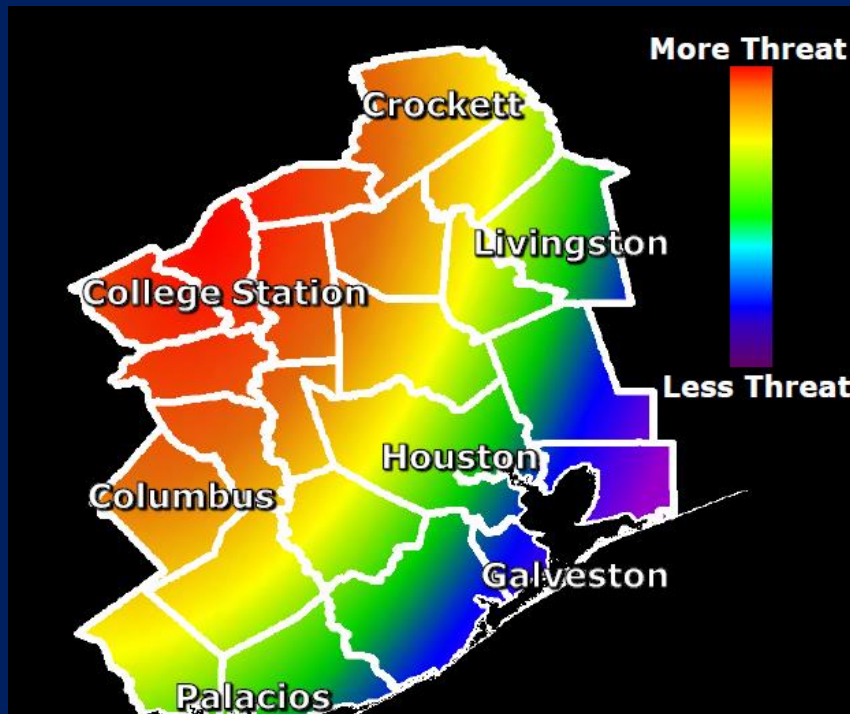
