Position Summary:

Maintains safe swimming conditions in the pool, deck, and surrounding areas. Creates a safe and positive atmosphere that promotes member safety and engagement, youth development and healthy living in accordance with City of Oak Ridge North policies and procedures.

Essential Functions:

1. Maintains constant surveillance of the pool area.
2. Maintains the safety of patrons in and around the pool.
3. Communicate and enforce all regulations and pool rules in a personable and professional manner.
4. Communicate any potentially dangerous elements of the facility to supervisor.
5. Remain alert and use all senses while guarding.
6. Test the water, record results and report imbalances to supervisor.
7. Be able to respond to emergency and contact/activate EMS.
8. Handle all incidents in a manner appropriate to your training.
9. Knows, understands, and consistently applies safety rules, policies, and guidelines for the pool area.
10. Performs equipment checks and ensures appropriate equipment is available as needed.
11. Attends all staff meetings and training as required.
12. Performs effectively on all required lifeguard audits and drills
13. Perform other duties as assigned.

Minimum Requirements

1. Minimum age of 15 years.
2. Current Red Cross or YMCA Lifeguard Certification preferred; Must obtain certification within 30 days of hire
3. CPR for the Professional Rescuer, AED, Basic First Aid, and Oxygen Administration certifications must be obtained within 30 days of hire
4. Ability to maintain certification-level of physical and mental readiness.
