

Summary Report from the City Council meeting of April 23, 2018.

1. A reminder that early voting has started for the City General election for Mayor and City Council Place #3. Registered voters can vote at any early voting location in Montgomery County. There is no early voting at City Hall. Election Day voting is Saturday, May 5th from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. at the Oak Ridge North City Hall.
2. City Council approved payment of \$11,500 for engineering costs for Robinson Road main lanes.
3. City Council approved payment of \$34,500 for engineering costs for a turn lane from Robinson Road into the Oak Ridge North Commerce Park. This is an Economic Development Corporation project.
4. City Council approved annexation of a 7.81-acre tract of land known as the Vaught tract, owned by the City into the City.
5. A deed conveying a 3.23-acre drainage ditch from the Vaught tract to the Drainage Ditch No. 6 (DD6) was approved.
6. Council approved amendments to the Capital Improvement Budget to add sources of revenue and expenditures for projects original scheduled in Fiscal Year 2017, but carrying over to Fiscal Year 2018.
7. Paula Cleveland was named to the Community Affairs Committee.
8. A lease payment, in the amount of \$20,000 was approved to Motorola for Police Radios.
