

Summary Report from the City Council meeting of May 30, 2018.

1. In a joint meeting and public hearing with the Planning & Zoning Commission, City Council approved an amendment to the Robinson Road Commercial District (RC-1) to allow leasing to commercial business (office uses).
2. Municipal Court Judge Bill Patillo was sworn in for a new two year term.
3. Council declared as surplus a list of Public Works equipment. The equipment will be sold in sealed auction on June 13th at 2 p.m. at City Hall. The list of equipment and details on the auction will be available on the city website.
4. Entergy Texas has filed a Statement of Intent with the City to increase electric rates and implement tariff rider surcharges in the Entergy service area. City Council approved an ordinance suspending the effective date of the proposed rates for an additional ninety days beyond June 19, 2018 to enable additional study of the rates by a joint cities steering committee formed by multiple municipalities.
