

Summary Report from City Council meeting of Monday, January 22, 2018:

1. City Secretary Elizabeth Harrell was recognized for 15 years of service with the City of Oak Ridge North. Mrs. Harrell has been a police officer for 15 years and was recently named City Secretary.
2. Sarah McClure, Community Programs Coordinator, announced that the City was named “Agency of the Year –Class 3 (under 40,000 population) by the Texas Public Pool Council for the City pool program. Ms. McClure also received a \$1,000 scholarship for professional training.
3. City Manager Vicky Rudy announced that the City received a \$2,500 grant from Entergy Texas for the City’s Home Rehabilitation program.
4. The City Council approved an ordinance amending and updating the Solid Waste guidelines to incorporate the new solid waste contract with Waste Management.
5. Council authorized the use of the Oak Ridge North City Hall for the March 6, 2018 primary elections. This is a temporary location being used to accommodate flood damage from Harvey at other primary election locations.
