



Construction permits are required for the following based on the 2009 International Fire Code, Section 105.7. Permit fees will be based off valuation. Permit fees are a set fee of 2.5% of the project contract fee. A copy of the signed contract must be provided to obtain the fire permit.

1. Automatic fire extinguishing systems.
2. Battery systems.
3. Compressed gases.
4. Cryogenic fluids.
5. Fire alarm and detection systems and related equipment.
6. Fire pumps and related equipment.
7. Flammable and combustible liquids.
8. Hazardous materials.
9. Industrial ovens.
10. LP-gas.
11. Private fire hydrants.
12. Spraying or dipping.
13. Standpipe systems.
14. Temporary membrane structures and tents.
